Our Belief

We are not trying to advertise to the world about how good we are. He didn't save us to be chinaware sitting on a shelf as fragile showpieces, He saved us to "...shew forth the praises of Him who hath called (us) out of darkness into His marvellous light: " (1Pet. 2:9) And to make all men see what is the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God, who created all things by Jesus Christ: To the intent that now unto the principalities and powers in heavenly places might be known by the church the manifold wisdom of God... ..that (we), being rooted and grounded in love, may be able to comprehend with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height; And to know the love of Christ, which (surpasses) knowledge, that (we) might be filled with all the fulness of God." (Eph.3)

In a world full of selfishness, self-centeredness, hate, and pride, this is accomplished by loving our neighbor, and laying our lives down for the brethren. Not some wishy-washy, feel-good, Sunday morning love, but a genuine love for our fellow man that manifests itself in daily life. Because Jesus said, *"by this shall all men know you are my disciples, if you have love one for another."* John 13:34-35

The world will never know the power of God's love through Jesus Christ unless God's people can manifest it themselves with each other.

Are we there yet? Absolutely not, but that is our aim and the focal point of every decision we make.
